**WEDNESDAY, JUNE 17, 2020** Upon checking in at the hotel, you will have time to unpack before joining the Asolo Rep Adventurers for a meet & greet at DlBar, the hotel's on-site bar and lounge. We will then board the luxury motor coach and drive to our Welcome Dinner at a local restaurant.

THURSDAY, JUNE 18, 2020 The Royal Ontario Museum is among the top 10 cultural institutions in North America and Canada's largest and most comprehensive museum – home to a world-class collection of 13 million artworks, cultural objects and natural history specimens, featured in 40 gallery and exhibition spaces. Spend the morning on a private tour at the museum, followed by a free afternoon. In the evening, we will attend a private reception with cocktails and heavy hors d'oeuvres at the Toronto home of an Asolo Rep Board Member, followed by our first theatre production (to be announced).

FRIDAY, JUNE 19, 2020 The day will begin with a driving tour of Toronto, accompanied by a knowledgeable tour guide, followed by a group lunch at a local restaurant. Following lunch, we will visit The Art Gallery of Ontario for a private tour. AGO is one of the largest art museums in North America with a collection of close to 95,000 works ranging from cutting-edge contemporary art to European masterpieces. **SATURDAY, JUNE 20, 2020** After checking out of the Four Seasons Hotel, we will board the luxury motor coach and make our way to Niagara-on-the-Lake. **TUESDAY, JUNE 23, 2020** We will begin the morning with a private backstage tour of the Shaw Festival Theatre. Inspired by George Bernard Shaw, the Shaw Festival is a contemporary theatre that features a smart, provocative, potent and diverse mix of plays from the past and present. Following the tour, our group will get a unique dining experience on the beautiful grounds of the Festival Theatre with a pre-matinee catered picnic lunch.
