## Asolo Rep Announces 2017-18 IllumiNation Series; Kicks off with Spanish Supertitled *EVITA* on December 6

**(SARASOTA, November 20, 2017)** — Asolo Rep proudly announces its 2017-18 **IllumiNation Series**, promoting cross-cultural conversations in the community. Held during select Wednesday and Saturday performances throughout the 2017-18 season, **IllumiNation** events begin one hour prior to curtain with a reception on the mezzanine, continue with the performance, and conclude with a free and open-to-the-public community conversation where audience members can further explore the topical and social issues that they have just seen played out on stage. Five-play and three-play ticket packages are available for the series.

The first event of the season kicks off on December 6 at 6:30pm with *Evita* and features pre-show tango lessons and dancing, and Argentinean light bites. The 7:30pm performance features Spanish supertitles. Following the performance, audience members will have the opportunity to reflect upon and discuss the topical and social issues in *Evita* in a community conversation facilitated by Maria Schaedler-Luera. Maria Schaedler-Luera is the Program Manager for Arts Integration with Any Given Child Sarasota at the Sarasota County Schools and the Managing Director of Atomica Arts. She is a Brazilian-born educator administrator, and performing artist with extensive work experience and knowledge in theater, music, arts and literacy, cross-cultural engagement, ESOL, interpreting, and immigrant communities.

"In addition to producing great stories brilliantly told, Asolo Rep believes theatre can be a critical part of building social capital. Every show is an opportunity to create connectivity, enhance mutual understanding and, most vitally, develop true empathy," said Asolo Rep Producing Artistic Director Michael Donald Edwards. "Our **IllumiNation Series** is at the heart of this mission. Along with our other community programming, we aim to deepen the experience for all who come to see the work, as well as to reach new audiences."

This season's **IllumiNation** events also include **Morning After Grace**, **Roe**, **Gloria** and **Ragtime**. In order to effectively reach these audiences, Asolo Rep is working closely with an **IllumiNation** Advisory Committee, comprised of community pillars who are committed to broadening the diversity of the theatre.

The committee is headed this season by Mary Braxton-Joseph, an Emmy Award-winning journalist and media consultant. An Asolo Rep Board member, Mary Braxton-Joseph is Immediate Past Chair of the Lillian's List Action Fund of North Carolina.

"The **IllumiNation** Series provides an opportunity for a public conversation about race, identity and cultural intersection," said committee chair Mary Braxton-Joseph. "I got involved because I wanted to participate in the dialogue and move the conversation forward. I have been amazed and uplifted by the quality of the conversations that take place after the performances."
